Description of Facilities All rooms of the Club are open to mixed company. Children over the age of 12 and under direct supervision are permitted in all areas of the Club (excluding bar). Children under the ages of 12 (excluding accommodation) prior approval is required by the Club Secretary.

Club Etiquette **No denim, commercial advertising, gym wear or sports footwear are to be worn within any public areas of the Club.**

Gentlemen are required to wear "coat & tie" on Levels 1, 2, 3 of the Club with ladies required to dress accordingly (e.g. lengthened dress or skirt, business wear). "Modern Professional" applies on the Ground Floor at all times – i.e. button shirt with collar - (*tucked in*), suit jacket, tailored trousers and dress shoes for men; the equivalent for women.

In-house guests may wear casual attire upon entering or leaving the Club, however alternate entry and exit via the lower ground car park is preferred

Making mobile phone calls is NOT permitted in the public areas of the Club. Please see Reception for the dedicated areas to make calls.

Laptops may only be used in the Business Centre, Dangar Room desks and private function rooms.

No Photography or Filming is permitted anywhere in the club unless permission has been given by the Club Secretary.
